The Weir Farm Artist-In-Residence Program continues this July, welcoming [Linda Smith](#). Linda was originally slated to complete her residency in April 2020 but due to the pandemic we had to put a pause on the program. We are grateful for the opportunity to now have her participate in the program and we are thankful for her patience and flexibility.

Linda Smith is an artist and art educator who started a non-profit while living in Kigali, Rwanda, called the "TEOH Project", which provides cameras and art classes to children in Rwanda, Ghana and Bronx NY. She has been commissioned by the UN to provide photographic classes to survivors and former perpetrators of the 1994 genocide in Rwanda. She earned her BFA from Syracuse University, an MA in Communications at Goldsmith College at the University of London and an MFA from the University of Connecticut. Her work has been exhibited in the United Nations, Embassies and Universities.

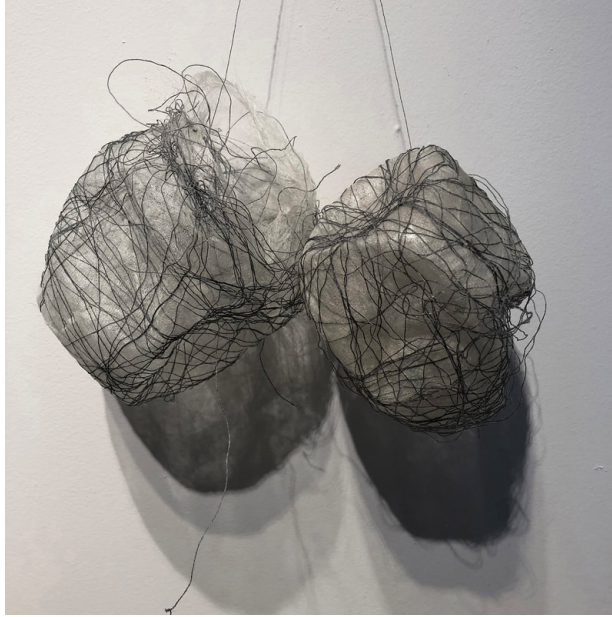

Weir Farm's Artist-in-Residence program (AIR) selects artists through a jury process to live and work at Weir Farm each year. To date, over 230 artists from throughout the U.S., as well as Tunisia, Germany, Australia, India and the Netherlands have participated in the AIR program. Visual artists apply for one month residencies in all media and diverse artistic points of view from traditional to experimental.
