


Welcomes October 2023 Weir Farm Artist-in-Residence Victoria van der Laan

Victoria van der Laan is a visual artist working in Albany, NY. A self/generationally taught textile artist, van der Laan carries the knowledge and tradition of quilt-making forward in her sewn paintings, echoing the work of her ancestors while innovating new possibilities for the form. Her intention is to champion women's work broadly and quilts specifically as dually powerful: encompassing both function and art and embodying the ingenuity and artistic voice of marginalized folk, and her distinct voice among them.

"My work is an abstract interpretation of the traditional quilt-making techniques I learned from my Grandmothers," says van der Laan. "The painstaking handwork of my forebears never far from my mind as I work, I am committed to revealing the

inextricable connection between the traditions of Women's Work and fine art."






More about October's Artist-in-Residence

In 2019, van der Laan had her first two-person exhibit at the Roxbury Arts Group in Roxbury, NY and participated in the Catskill Center's Platte Clove Residency in 2018 and 2019 She was chosen as the 2020 Murray Fellow for the Elizabeth Murray Artist Residency and attended the Millay Arts Core Residency in 2022. Her work has been included in the 2019, 2020, and 2021 Artists of the Mohawk Hudson Region Exhibitions, 2020 Quilts=Art=Quilts Exhibition at the Schweinfurth Art Center, and the 2020 Mohawk Hudson Regional Invitational at Albany Center Gallery. In 2022, van der Laan had her first solo exhibition, Remembered Geometries, at Spring Street Gallery in Saratoga Springs, NY. Her work is part of the permanent collections of The Albany Institute of History and Art in Albany, NY and The Hyde Collection in Glens Falls, NY.
